Introduction

As part of the nationwide 'Har Ghar Tiranga' campaign, an Awareness Programme on the National Flag (Tiranga) was jointly organized by the National Service Scheme (NSS), Unit II, and the National Cadet Corps (NCC) of Panchakot Mahavidyalaya. The programme was convened with the objective of fostering a deeper sense of patriotism among students and sensitizing them to the history, significance, and appropriate protocol associated with the National Flag, in keeping with the spirit of the campaign initiated by the Government of India.

Proceedings of the Programme

The programme commenced at 12:30 PM in the Panchakot Mahavidyalaya Auditorium with the singing of the National Song and the National Anthem, which set a solemn and dignified tone for the proceedings.

This was followed by an introductory speech delivered by Dr. Suvajit Halder, Programme Officer, NSS, Unit II, who welcomed the dignitaries, faculty members, and student volunteers, and outlined the objectives and relevance of the Har Ghar Tiranga campaign in strengthening national consciousness among the youth.

The keynote address of the programme, on the theme of the History of the Indian National Flag, was delivered by Dr. Jayanta Das, Coordinator, IQAC, Panchakot Mahavidyalaya. In his address, Dr. Das traced the evolution of the Indian National Flag from the pre-independence period

to its present form, elaborating upon the symbolism of its colours and the Ashoka Chakra, as well as the flag code and the protocols governing its display and use. His address enriched the participants' understanding of the flag as a symbol of the nation's sovereignty, unity, and collective struggle for freedom.

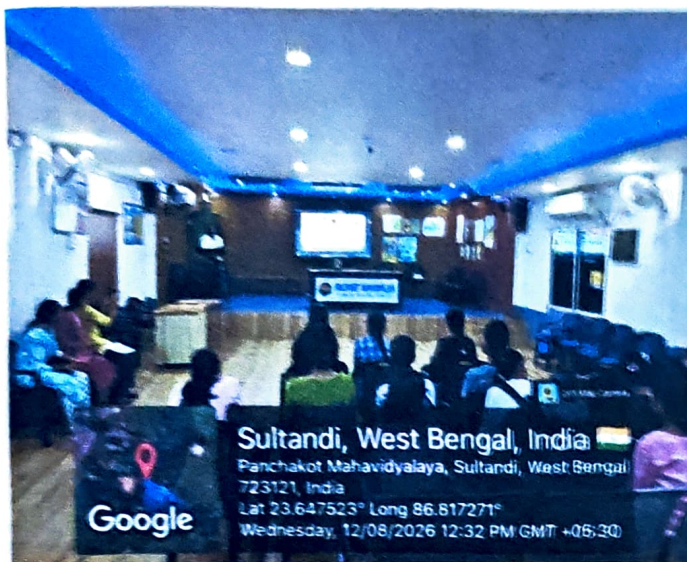

Outcome

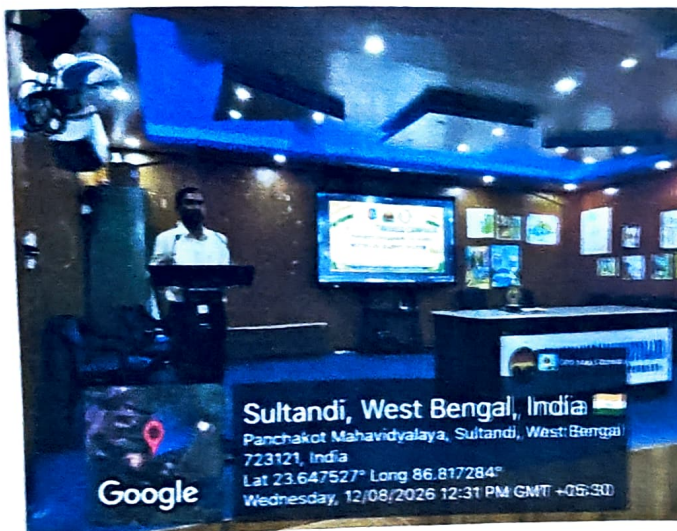

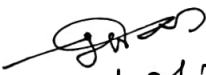

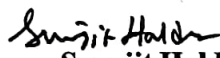
