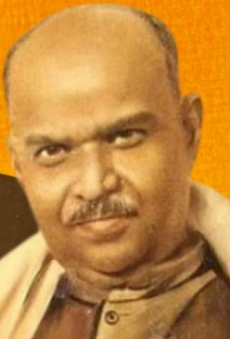

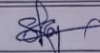
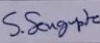

- Arrange similar awareness programmes regularly.

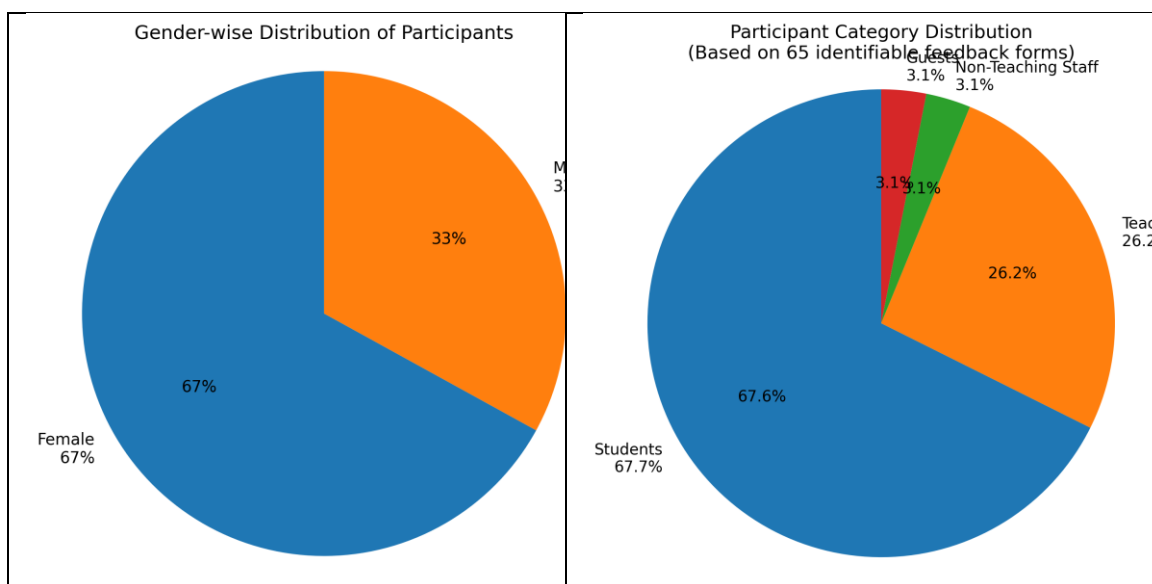

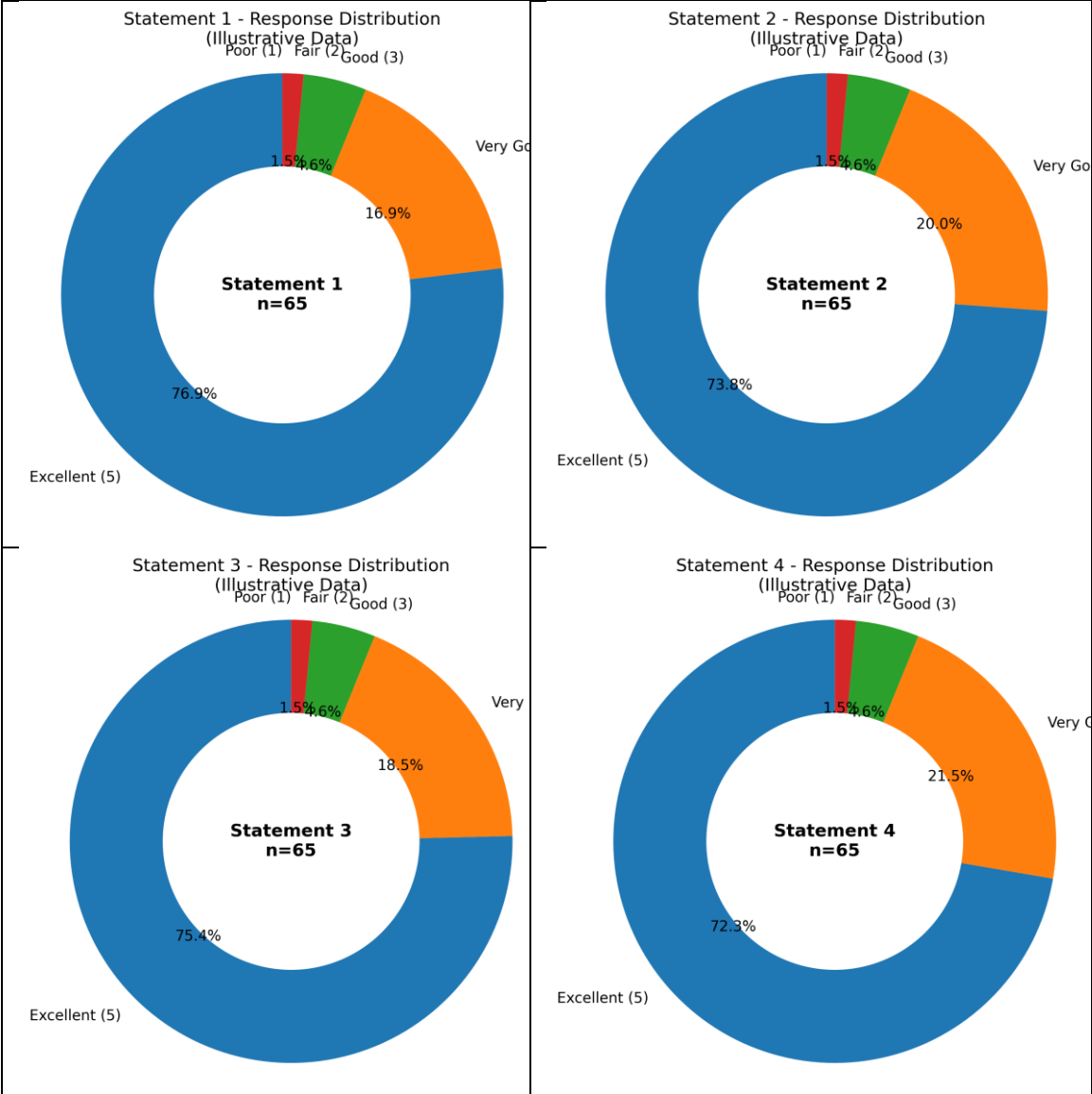

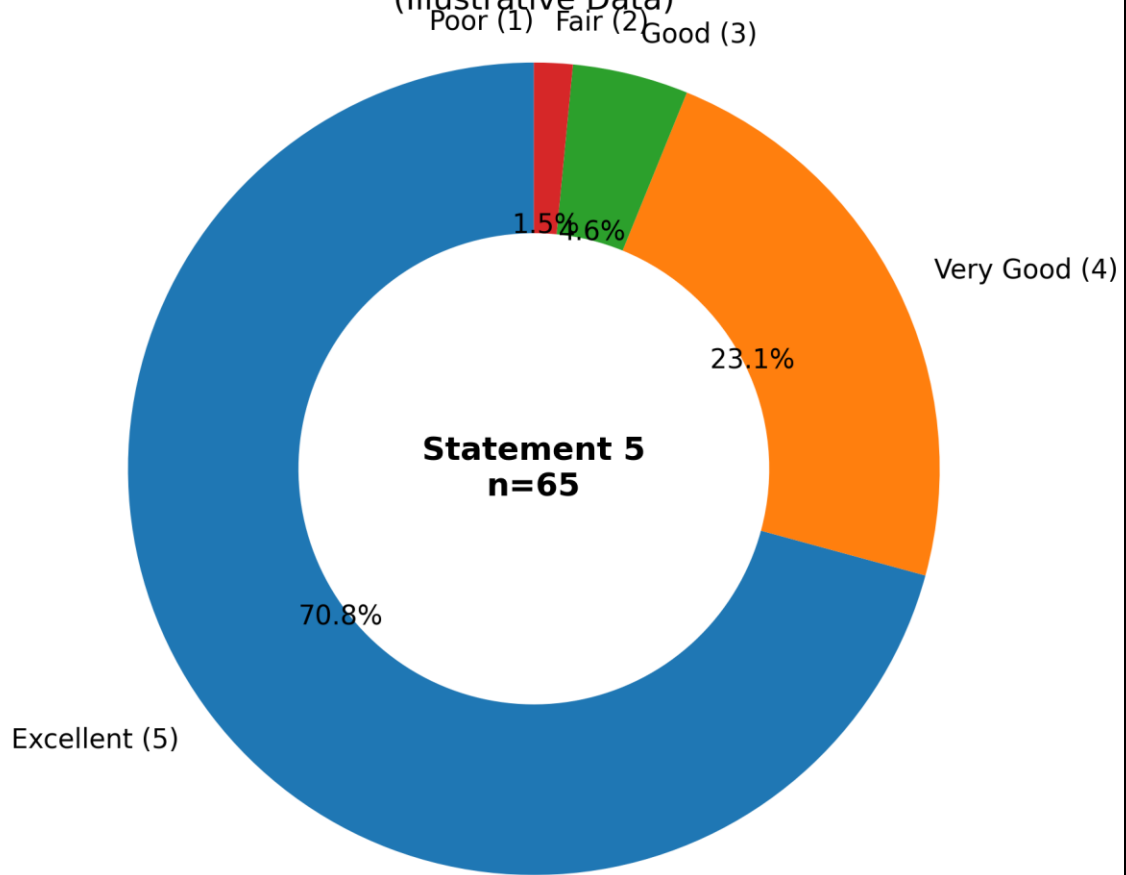
Outcome of the Feedback Analysis

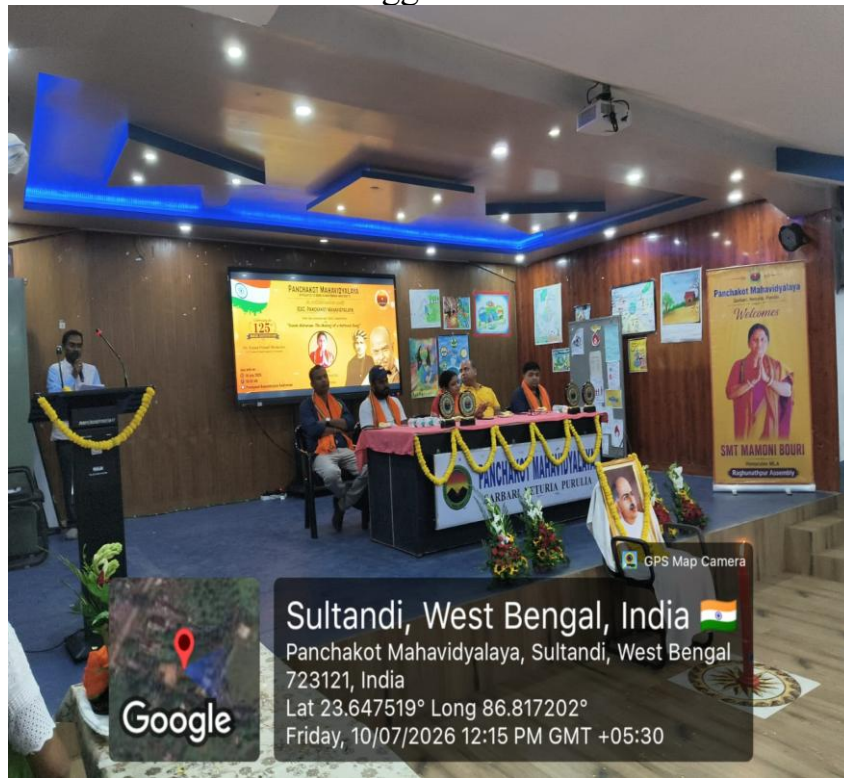


Figure 1: During the conduction Session 1 of the Seminar.

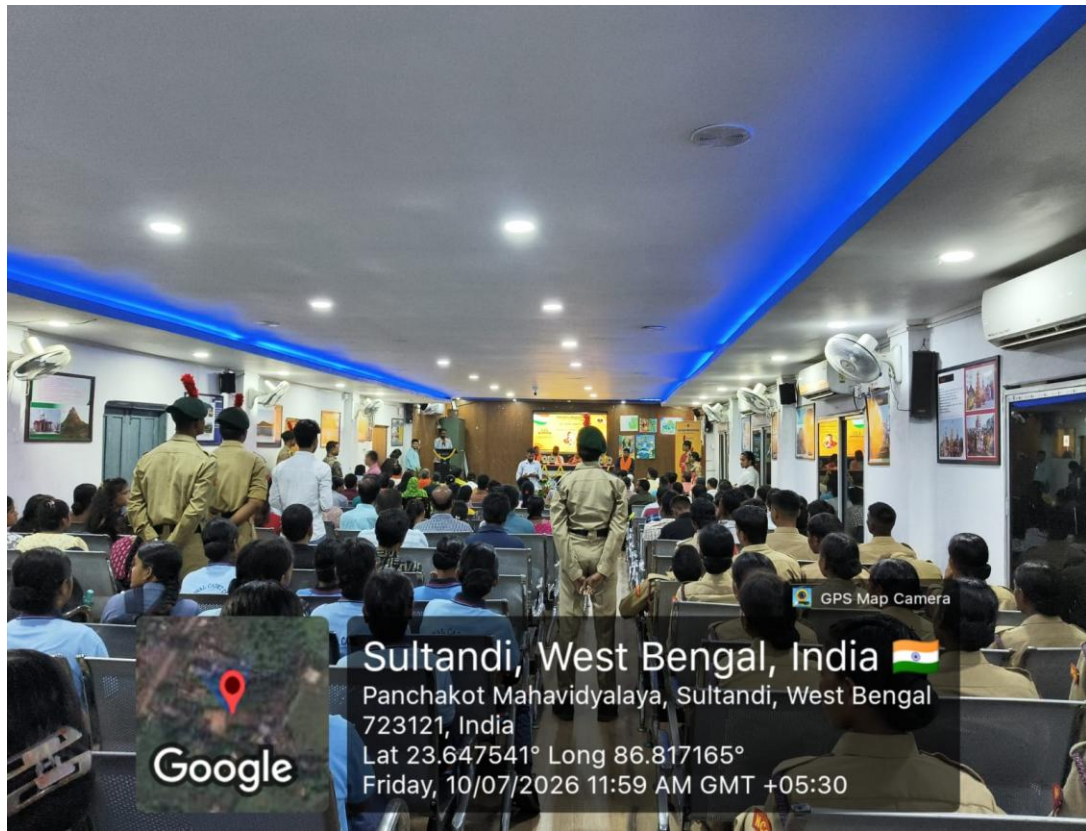


Figure 3: Students, Teacher, and NTS are actively participating
