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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

WHEREAS the Government of India, Ministry of Education, is committed to the development and improvement of the educational system in the state of West Bengal; and WHEREAS the Government of West Bengal, Ministry of Education, is committed to the development and improvement of the educational system in the state of West Bengal; and WHEREAS the Government of India, Ministry of Education, and the Government of West Bengal, Ministry of Education, have agreed to the subject of the MOU, which includes the following:

1. The Government of India, Ministry of Education, shall provide technical assistance and training to the Government of West Bengal, Ministry of Education, for the purpose of improving the quality of education in the state of West Bengal.

For the Government of India, Ministry of Education, the undersigned is authorized to sign this MOU on behalf of the Government of India, Ministry of Education.

- B. First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- C. The parties intend to cooperate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training, Education and Research.
- D. Both parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MOU for advancing their mutual interests.
- E. S2-LINK TRAINING, DEVELOPMENT & PLACEMENT ACADEMY, the Second Party is engaged in Skill Development, Training & Placement in the fields of MINISTRY OF MICRO, SMALL & MEDIUM ENTERPRISES under Udyog Aadhaar No: WB18D001
- F. S2-LINK TRAINING, DEVELOPMENT & PLACEMENT ACADEMY, the Second Party is promoted by VIDYASATHI, BRAINTRUST EDUTECH Pvt. Ltd. 303/D Diamond Harbour Road, Behala, Kolkata-34

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

CLAUSE 1

CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First Party providing significant inputs to them in developing suitable teaching/training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the industry, the Second Party.
- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MOU shall represent the entire understanding as to the subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

CLAUSE 2

SCOPE OF THE MOU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological up-gradation, innovation and competitiveness of an industry. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 Curriculum Design: Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching/training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully.

2.3 Industrial Training & Visits: Industry and Institution interaction will give an insight in to the latest developments/requirements of the industries; the Second Party to permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its group companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to students and faculty through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Labs / Workshops/ Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.

2.4 Research and Development: Both Parties have agreed to monitor the joint research activities in the fields of **Soft Skills, Student Development & Corporate Culture**.

2.5 Skill Development Programs: Second Party to train the students of First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the skill gap and make them industry ready.

2.6 Guest Lectures: Second party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecturers to the students of the first party on the corporate trends, philosophy and in house requirements.

2.7 Placement of Trained Students: Second Party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of students of the First Party into Internships/jobs; and will facilitate placements assistance to all the students after successful completion of the course.

2.8 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein.

2.9 There is no financial commitment on the part of the Second Party to First Party, the First party is liable to pay INR 1275 (One Thousand Two Hundred Seventy five only) to the Second Party for four months training programme as fees.

CLAUSE 3

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MOU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppels or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

CLAUSE 4

VALIDITY

4.1 This Agreement will be valid for 2023-2025 financial year and will be further extended for another 3 (Three) forthcoming consecutive financial year until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MOU. Any act on the part of Training Partner, the Second Party after termination of this Agreement by way of communication, correspondence etc., shall not be construed as an extension of this MOU.

4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

CLAUSE 5

RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MOU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MOU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MOU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party. 5.2 The First Party is therefore need to give support in regard to virtual class room & need to extend hospitality towards institute Industry convergence speaker as well as interviewers during their campus recruitment drive if any.

Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MOU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of PURULIA TOWN.

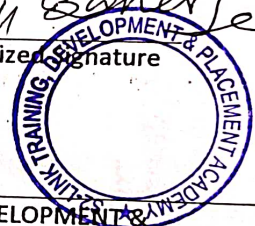
