

A Report on Anti-Ragging Awareness Program 27th September 2023, Wednesday

Title of the Session: Anti-Ragging Awareness and Anti-Ragging Online Affidavit

About the Session:

The Anti-Ragging Cell of Panchakot Mahavidyalaya organized a talk and PowerPoint presentation on 'Anti-Ragging Awareness and Online Affidavit' on 27 September 2023 for the newly admitted students of the college. This awareness session was held in the seminar hall with all newly admitted students of Panchakot Mahavidyalaya. The session was attended by more than 100 students. The 'Anti-Ragging Awareness Programme' aimed at making students aware of the laws of the country with respect to ragging and how it affects the lives of people victimized by it.

The programme commenced with Dr. Joydev Panda, Convenor of the Anti-Ragging Committee, introducing the session's importance for freshers in college life. Dr Joydev Panda started the awareness session by defining ragging as stated by the Honorable Supreme Court of India and Raghavan Committee and then proceeded to discuss a few cases of ragging in India that resulted in death and severe damage to the mental state of the victim and victim's family. He also discussed various forms of ragging to make sure that the students are able to understand which activities are stated as ragging in UGC rules and regulations. He discussed the various administrative punishments given in the case of ragging.

Dr. Panda explained the importance of the Anti-Ragging Affidavit for every student for every year. He provided knowledge on how to file an affidavit on the UGC portal. He educated the students on the procedures for registering complaints and how to participate in making ragging free campus. He responded to queries from students with respect to anti-ragging and the talk concluded with a call to 'Say no to Ragging'.

Newly admitted students of Panchakot Mahavidyalaya enjoyed the PowerPoint presentation of this Awareness programme. They understood the various definitions of ragging. The students learned various anti-ragging Laws. They knew how and where to lodge the complaint against ragging. They also learned how to file the anti-ragging affidavit and its importance. They realized their responsibility to keep their campus ragging-free.
