Title of the Session: Anti-Ragging Awareness

About the Session:

The anti-Ragging Cell of Panchakot Mahavidyalaya conducted the “Anti-Ragging Awareness Programme” on 26 September 2023 for all the Non-teaching staff of the college. This awareness session was held in the seminar hall with all Non-teaching of Panchakot Mahavidyalaya.

Dr Joydev Panda, Convener, of the Anti Ragging Committee of the institution addressed the Non-teaching staff and briefed them about the different strategies and action plans for curbing the menace of ragging in the college by adopting various measures and activities.

He also addressed the Non-teaching staff about the origin and menace of ragging in India and also explained the legal consequences of involvement in such activities. He also reiterated that anyone who is actively or passively or is a part of a conspiracy to promote ragging is liable to be punished. He also inspired them on how Non-teaching staff can stand by the victim students, how to help them, and how to guide them to prevent ragging. He gave step-by-step instructions on how students can file an affidavit online, how to lodge a complaint, and where students can get help.

Non-teaching staff of Panchakot Mahavidyalaya enjoyed the PowerPoint presentation of this Awareness program. They understood the various definitions of ragging. They also learned various anti-ragging Laws. They understood how to help the students to lodge the complaint against ragging and to file the anti-ragging affidavit.
